

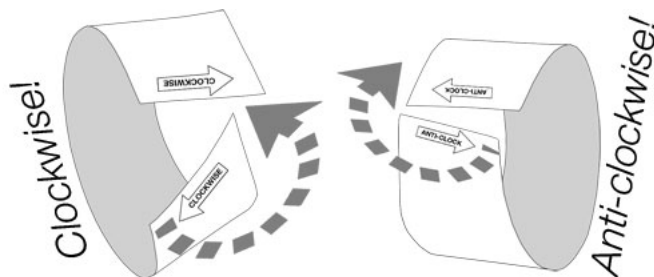
CLOCKWISE

Mathematical Valentine's Card

Nothing says "I love your sexy brain" like a topological challenge!

Step 001: Cut out both strips of paper from this sheet, or make your own strips with a personalised message.

Step 010: Glue the ends of each strip together so that arrows are pressed together. To make the arrows line up, you will need to turn one end of the strip over; make sure you do this in a clockwise direction for one strip and an anti-clockwise direction for the other.



Step 011: Glue the two loops together at right-angles.



Step 100: Give the resulting shape to a loved-one for them to cut in half. This will turn the shape into two inter-linked hearts, and you'll be on your way to the centre of the mathematics-romance venn diagram.
